Race News

June 12 – Fast Course

Twenty-four racers duked it out in the fourth race of the season. Kim Nakashima (#1), Garry Combs (#3), and Bruce Ramsey (#24) debuted their brand new 2005 GSX-R1000s. Garry felt right at home on his and finished the day by taking a first and second in F-1 and in Open Superstreet. Kim didn't fare as well, low-siding in the off-camber in race 2 of F-1.



Tyrone Montayre (#4) led the way in 600 Superstreet taking both heats with Sean Mason (#32) second each time. Noah Gietka (#20) moved up from Novice and completed his first expert race in 600SS with a pair of 4th place finishes and in 600 Production with a pair of 3rds. Tyrone continues to lead the way for the “iron man” award, running in three classes.

Three classes were run with just two competitors each, Aaron Abaya (#6) and

Greg Lumpkin (#42) in 750 Superstreet and Robert Bessara (#7) and Tom Cesar (#22) in Formula II and Formula III.

Open Superstreet continues to hold the most interest this season. There were nine entrants, including the return of Derek Russell (#69) on his RC-51. Welcome back!

Seven novices took to the track, including newcomers Jose Fabre (#38) and Sean Canfield (#95). Jose took a first and second in Big Bike on his R1. Dave Ziemann (#66) returned after a one race absence and Frog Davis continued to show the way in Novice Small Bike.
