## Race News

### January 30 – Long Course

Twenty-four racers kicked off the 2005 season on Sunday, January 30 at Hawaii Raceway Park. Layden Paulino (#2) came out in a brilliantly painted Kawasaki ZX-10R and Quinn Swift (#12) proved that he is aptly named, finishing one/two in Open Supersport. This could be the hotly contested class this season, with nine racers making the starting grid. Kim Nakashima (#1) and Aaron Abaya (#6) continued their winning ways in Formula I and 600 Production, respectively. The excitement of round one occurred in



the 750SS race when Guy Caruso (#37) tried to catch a ride on the back of Garry Combs' bike entering the chicane, sending both to the tarmac and Garry off to dreamland.



The “iron man” of the day was Tyrone Montayre (#4), who ran in four classes, resulting in two firsts, one third, and a fourth place. Joey Riveira (#9) had lonely races in Formula II and Formula III with only Tom Cesar (#22) keeping him company in FIII on his newly acquired TZ125. Six novices took to the track; Ken (#16) and Noah (#20) led the way in their respective classes.
